- Foster a conducive residential environment that supports academic learning and professional development.

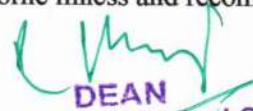

Roles and Responsibilities

Food Safety and Mess Management

1. Monitor quality, quantity, nutritional adequacy, and affordability of food served in hostel messes.
2. Ensure procurement, storage, preparation, and serving of food follow established food safety and hygiene standards.
3. Conduct periodic inspections of kitchens, dining halls, food storage areas, and water supply systems.
4. Verify personal hygiene practices and periodic health check-ups of food handlers.
5. Ensure safe drinking water through regular testing and maintenance of purification systems.
6. Review menus periodically to ensure balanced nutrition and accommodate medical or dietary requirements where feasible.
7. Monitor waste management, grease disposal, and cleanliness of food preparation areas.
8. Investigate complaints regarding food quality, hygiene, or suspected food-borne illness and recommend corrective measures.
